Application Deadline - April 5th at 5PM EST. Please log into Symplicity to complete the application and employer confirmation form.

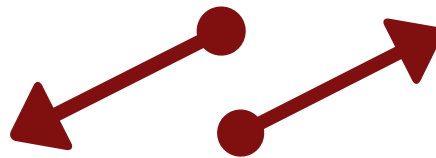
