Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – for federal loans ONLY

North Carolina Central University is an institutional participant in the Federal Direct Student Loan Program. You may apply for federal loans to defray the expense of tuition and fees. The University's Office of Scholarships and Student Aid must have a current FAFSA in order to process your federal direct student loans and other University financial aid including law school scholarships and grants. The **FAFSA** is available <u>here</u>. The FAFSA school code for North Carolina Central University is <u>002950</u>. The law school uses the University's school. There is not a separate school code for the law school.
