# Sports & Entertainment Law

## *Contract Negotiation Seminar & Information Session*

On Thursday, November 18, 2021, Career Services hosted a Sports & Entertainment Contract Negotiation Seminar and Information Session. This session featured Attorney James Walker Jr., Brittney Griner WNBA player and two-time Olympic Champion, and Penny Toler, Former Executive Vice President and General Manager of the three-time WNBA Champions Los Angeles Sparks.

### **Brittney Griner**

Ms. Griner was the first Round Draft Pick of the Phoenix Mercury. In 2012, the three-time All-American was named the AP Player of the Year and the Most Outstanding Player of the Final Four. She also received the Best Female Athlete ESPY Award. Griner was also on the USA Olympic Women's Team, where she helped lead them to victory at the 2016 and 2020 Olympics.

### **Attorney James L. Walker Jr.**

Attorney Walker is a 25-year legal veteran having represented hundreds of artists, athletes, and entertainers. He negotiated one of the first ever WNBA contracts for a star player in the 1990s and has worked with several athletes since that time. Walker has negotiated contracts and legal matters with various networks and television outlets, including BET, TVOne, VH-1, ABC, A&E/Lifetime, CBS.

### **Penny Toler**

Ms. Toler was the longest-tenured and "winningest" general manager in WNBA history. Toler became general manager in 1999 and won the WNBA Championship title two years later, making her the fastest person in professional sports, male or female, to go from being a player to general manager to winning a championship.

The NCCU SOL Career Services Office has four mentoring collaborations. Please see details of each mentoring program below.



### IBM

The IBM Legal Diversity Mentor Program began its second year with NCCU for the 2021-22 school year. This was an opportunity for 2Ls and higher to be matched with an IBM Attorney specializing in:

- Intellectual Property
- Data Privacy
- Cybersecurity
- Technology Transactions
- Corporate Governance
- Mergers/Acquisitions and Finance

Mentors and mentees meet regularly one-on-one, currently virtually. IBM Mentors provide feedback on resumes, interview skills and overall professionalism. There are 15 students participating in the IBM mentorship program.

### Intel

The NCCU/Intel Tech Law & Policy Mentorship Program is for 2Ls or higher interested in a career being a lawyer/advisor to technology clients. There are 24 students participating in the Intel mentorship program.

### Dell

The Dell Legal Mentorship Program for 2Ls and higher exists to benefit mentees, mentors, and the legal profession in general. One-on-one mentoring with a Dell attorney helps promote Dell's philosophy for developing diverse talent.

Mentors will assist NCCU law students make meaningful professional relationships and reach a deeper understanding of the legal profession's responsibilities and ethics. The mentoring program is open to all students, including 1Ls. Key mentoring topics that will be explored are academics, careers, community engagement and professionalism. There are 130 students in the NCCU Career Services mentoring program.
