# **Dean's Corner**

# Advice for the Coming Year

We know many of you want to know if you are on the right track, doing what you should be doing, and thinking about what you should be doing. You might be feeling overwhelmed. It's a lot.

Let's go back to the basics. Each of you, depending on where you are in your law school career, should be thinking about or doing certain things in order to prepare yourself fully to land your first permanent positon. Of course, you should always discuss your particular interest with your Career Services Office.

Here is a quick overview of some of the things you should be doing as a 1L, 2L/1LE, 3L/2LE/3LE/4LE:

IL/ILEs: Hang tight. Focus on your classes. We will be in touch in October to give you some food for thought and a road map for moving forward in all of your career endeavors. We hope that once you are able, you take full advantage of all the Career Services Office has to offer and meet with us frequently. The more proactive you are, the more we can help you.

**2Ls/2LEs/3LEs:** If you are not currently working or volunteering in the legal field, or working in an externship or clinic, you should

be! Come talk to us to discuss how to gain legal experience before you graduate. Gaining practical experience before you graduate from law school should be a top priority. Employers look for students who can join their offices and take on a caseload immediately. You should also keep your resume updated with each new position or accomplishment so that it is always ready to send out should an opportunity present itself.

**3Ls/4LEs:** You should consider this crunch time with one year left. Be sure to attend key networking events and update your resume. Participate in community activities that provide valuable experiences working with the public and meeting professionals in your area and locations of interest. It is never too late to build your network! You need to apply for positions broadly, network, and talk to everyone you encounter about your goals and aspirations. Be sure that you tailor your interests to the person you are speaking to. Few professionals are willing to go on a limb for a recent graduate who cannot articulate their interests or be persuasive on why they should be hired. Likewise, when you do apply for each position, make sure you show attention to detail so that potential employers know that you are taking them seriously.

If you are currently employed, talk to your boss or supervisor about your prospects of being hired there on a permanent basis post-graduation. Now is the time to have this conversation. It is not too early. You need to be able to plan ahead and know where you stand with your current employer. If you are not currently employed, it would be worth it to look for a part-time law clerk position now or extern. This would give you the opportunity to gain valuable experience and make contacts right before you graduate.
