# 2022 FALL OCI (ON-CAMPUS INTERVIEWS)

Law firms and other legal employers will visit law schools nationwide during the fall to interview applicants. Students must request an interview early; slots fill up quickly.

Most large law firms do the majority of their hiring of new law graduates this way. Firms will plan to recruit and hire students to work during the summer between their second and third year. If the NCCU (North Carolina Central University) student performs well, firms often offer them full-time employment post-graduation.

NCCU LAW STUDENT BIDDING BEGINS JUNE 20TH

What types of employers will participate in the 2022 Fall OCI On-Campus Interviews)?

- Large Law Firms: These employers can establish their hiring needs a year in advance. On occasion, mid-size to small firms will participate. Typically, smaller law firms recruit when they need to fill immediate openings.
- Organizations & Consulting Firms:
   Sometimes accounting firms are interested in law graduates with accounting backgrounds for their tax departments.
   They are generally interested in interviewing (2L, 2LE, 3L, 3LE, 4LE).

How to receive important OCI (On-Campus Interview) deadlines and announcements by:

- Click on <u>Symplicity</u>, and create an account profile.
- Check your emails regularly for important OCI dates and announcements.
- Meet with a career counselor in NCCU
   Dept. Of Law Career Services and
   Professional Development to discuss OCI
   readiness strategies.
- Register as soon as OCI Bidding Opens,
  June 20th. Slots can fill up quickly!
  Once OCI Bidding opens, NCCU Law
  students will want to read each employer's
  eligibility criteria carefully and consult their
  career counselor regarding any questions
  about their eligibility to participate or apply.
