## Leadership Council on Legal Diversity (LCLD)

The 1L LCLD Scholars Program offers first-year law students from diverse/underrepresented backgrounds\* the opportunity to spend a summer working with attorneys from LCLD Member organizations. 195 LCLD Member law firms and corporations participated in the 2022 program, collectively offering more than 860 opportunities. Opportunities for 2023 are currently being added by LCLD Members.

### Eligibility and Application Process:

- 1L LCLD Scholar candidates must be enrolled as first-year law students and in good standing at an ABA-approved law school.
- Candidates must apply directly to their desired LCLD Member firms and corporations; each Member organization will independently identify, select, and hire its 1L LCLD Scholar(s).
